What is the overall deductible?	\$0	See the Common Medical Events Chart below for your costs for services this plan covers.
Are there services covered before you meet your deductible?	No.	See the Common Medical Events Chart below for your costs for services this plan covers.
Are there other deductibles for specific services?	Yes, Prescription drugs -\$500 Individual/\$1,000 Family, does not apply to Tier 1 drugs. There are no other specific deductibles.	You must pay all of the costs for these services up to the specific deductibles amount before this plan begins to pay for these services.
What is the out-of-pocket limit for this plan?	Network: \$3,000 Individual / \$6,000 Family Per calendar year.	The out-of-pocket limit is the most you could pay in a year for covered services. If you have other family members in this plan, they have to meet their own out-of-pocket limits until the overall family out-of-pocket limit has been met.
What is not included in the out-of-pocket limit?	Premiums, balance-billing charges, health care this plan doesn't cover.	Even though you pay these expenses, they don't count toward the out-of-pocket limit.

Do you need a referral to see a specialist?	No	You can see the specialist you choose without a referral.

### Does this plan provide Minimum Essential Coverage? Yes
